

# SUMMER SECURITY CHECKLIST

What door and locks do you have on your property?



You should consider upgrading our locks to British Standard. If you have a wooden door more than 44mm thick, a 5-lever mortice lock is best.

Do you have window security?



If every window does not have a lock, then consider installing a key operated window lock, a door bolt (key operated bolt / hinge bolt) or a London bar.

What home security system do you have?

From burglar alarms, inside cameras, outdoor security cameras or security lighting, make sure everything is working and is offering the best security.



Do you have any extra exterior door security?

Door chains, door viewers or letterbox guards are key to give your door a bit of extra security from unwanted guests whilst keeping costs low.

How secure is your garden after the winter?

Trimming back your shrubbery/bushes will reduce intruder hiding spots. You can also check for weak points in your fencing whilst outside!

When was the last time you went in your Shed or your Garage?

It's important to check your shed and garage locks are intact, and the locks aren't damaged or rusted. Making sure you leave them locked is also essential.
