

What door and locks do you have on your property?

You should consider upgrading our locks to <u>British Standard</u>. If you have a wooden door more than 44mm thick, a 5-lever mortice lock is best.

Do you have window security?

If every window does not have a lock, then consider installing a key operated window lock, a door bolt (key operated bolt / hinge bolt) or a London bar.

What <u>home security system</u> do you have?

From <u>burglar alarms</u>, <u>inside cameras</u>, <u>outdoor security cameras</u> or <u>security lighting</u>, make sure everything is working and is offering the best security.

## SUMMER SECURITY CHECKLIST

Do you have any extra exterior door security?

Door chains, door viewers or letterbox guards are key to give your door a bit of extra security from unwanted guests whilst keeping costs low.

How secure is your <u>garden</u> after the winter?

Trimming back your shrubbery/bushes will reduce intruder hiding spots. You can also check for weak points in your <u>fencing</u> whilst outside!

When was the last time you went in your **Shed** or your **Garage**?

It's important to check your shed and garage locks are intact, and the locks aren't damaged or rusted. Making sure you leave them locked is also essential.
